

On the 5th and 6th of October 2017 the 3rd meeting of the CLIP-International cooperation – the guarantee of development of local products project was held in Thessaloniki, Greece. This project has been funded and supported by the European Commission.



The first day meeting has started with a speech of Niki Konstandinou the president of PASSKEDI (GRC) introducing the activities of the organization and welcoming the partners of all countries. Later was a presentation of the Greek team by Andreas Nachlas, what have done so far according the program.



The Greek host partner has introduced the organization web sites and activities in Greece and the agenda of the meeting,

that followed by a speech of the project coordinator (POL) showing the partners what have been done so far and next activities to be done by each partner, the coordinator summarized the current activities and focused on the involvement of local producers both in website and local/transnational activities, also mentioned the rule of each partner and the what have to be done in the next stages.

In this meeting, proposals and solutions to some problems related to the European product were presented in the face of importation of non-European products.
